## Localization:

The city center of Gdynia, 100 m from the beach, with excellent accommodation base, tourism and recreation, convenient urban transport and access: by car, ferry (to Sweden and Russia), train (direct connection to Berlin, Warsaw, Prague, Budapest, Kaliningrad), plane and even by bike, along so called "Northern Necklace Road".

## Accommodation:

Dormitories of Marine Academy in Gdynia, during the next three years will be renovated and their living standard will be significantly raised. Totally there will be a place for ca. 900 persons, including 200 persons in a hostel just next to the beach. Of course, Gdynia is a major sea resort, so there are several neighbouring hotels and pensions of widely varying prices as well, everybody will find something to his liking.

It's worth mentioning that the Euro 2012-related investments will improve both accommodation possibilities and public transport (in particular, connection to the Rebiechowo airport is going to be significantly improved).
