Open Croatian Go Championships

Zagreb, May 26-27, 2018

Croatian Go Alliance is honored to invite you to participate in Open Croatian Go Championship 2018. The tournament is the part of “The Second Croatian Go Week” (May 21-27, 2018), part of the project “Go – the game with(out) boundaries” (funded by the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Croatia). The project connects several primary and secondary schools and one kindergarten in Croatia, where the game of go is included in school regular activities.



Venue: Zagreb, Palinovecka 42, Primary School Alojzija Stepinca
Rules: McMahon system, 5 rounds, Japanese rules, komi 6.5 points
Time limits: Basic time: 60 minutes + Japanese byoyomi: 3x30 seconds

Fees:

20 EUR (150 HRK)	for players registered before 17th May 2018
10 EUR (75 HRK)	for players aged under 18
+5 EUR (+40 HRK)	for players registered after 17th May 2018

Prizes: 1st place: 40% of fees, 2nd place: 30% of fees, 3rd place: 20% of fees.
